We are looking for people to join our network of committed and passionate School & Youth volunteers in Leinster and Munster who are:

- Motivated to work with children and young people
- Have an interest in global justice and human rights
- Possess strong presentation skills
- Have excellent communication skills and fluency in English
- Possess great interpersonal skills
- Competent and confident in using IT programmes such as MS Powerpoint
- Flexible and committed to their role as volunteers
- Hold a full, clean driving licence and have access to a car
- Available to volunteer during school opening hours
- Willing to travel within their regions

The time commitment for this role is variable, however, volunteers can expect to deliver an average of 1-2 school visits per week during busy times of the year such as Lent.
